The successful execution of the programs detailed in this Annual Report is due to the steadfast support and collaboration of our esteemed supporters, staff and the general public.



ABOUT ABHINAV SAMAJ

ABHINAV SAMAJ is a voluntary social welfare organization committed to serving society with the spirit of compassion, dignity and selfless service. Established with the objective of supporting the underprivileged and marginalized sections of society ABHINAV SAMAJ works across various social, humanitarian, educational and legal domains to promote inclusive development and social justice. One of the key focus areas of ABHINAV SAMAJ is elderly care. The organization regularly supports needy senior citizens through old-age care initiatives, counseling, assistance in accessing government welfare schemes and by organizing free legal aid camps to address issues related to pensions, property disputes and social security. Special attention is given to destitute and abandoned elderly persons to ensure they live with dignity and respect.

ABHINAV SAMAJ is also actively involved in humanitarian and relief activities. The organization conducts free food distribution programs at government hospitals for attendants of poor patients ensuring that no one goes hungry during times of medical crisis. During winter months, blanket distribution drives are organized for homeless individuals, daily wage workers and families living in slum areas and on roads to protect them from extreme cold.

In the field of education and youth development ABHINAV SAMAJ implements programs aimed at empowering children and young adults. These include distribution of books and study materials to underprivileged children in slums, educational support initiatives and skill-development and training programs for college students to enhance their social awareness, leadership qualities and employability. A significant and unique service undertaken by ABHINAV SAMAJ is its Asthi Visarjan Sewa. The organization collects ashes of unclaimed bodies from cremation grounds in Delhi and performs their last rites according to Hindu traditions. The ashes are respectfully immersed in the holy river Ganga at Haridwar ensuring that even the most destitute individuals receive dignity in death and proper spiritual closure.

Additionally ABHINAV SAMAJ runs Legal Aid programs for economically weaker sections of society by organizing free legal counseling camps with the support of experienced advocates. These camps help beneficiaries understand their rights and seek justice without financial burden.

Through its wide range of activities ABHINAV SAMAJ strives to uphold human values, social harmony and national service. The organization continues to work tirelessly towards building a compassionate society where every individual, regardless of social or economic status, can live with dignity, security and hope.



MISSION

The mission of ABHINAV SAMAJ is to serve society through selfless humanitarian activities aimed at uplifting the underprivileged, supporting the elderly, empowering youth and ensuring dignity and care for all sections of society. ABHINAV SAMAJ is committed to addressing social challenges at the grassroots level through practical, compassionate and sustainable initiatives.

ABHINAV SAMAJ works to provide care and support to elderly persons through old age homes, regular assistance programs and free Legal Aid Camps for needy senior citizens. It strives to alleviate hunger and hardship by organizing free food distribution for attendants of poor patients at government hospitals and for destitute individuals.

A core mission of ABHINAV SAMAJ is to promote education and skill development by distributing books and study material to underprivileged children, conducting educational programs in slum areas and organizing training and value-based awareness programs for college students and youth.

ABHINAV SAMAJ is also dedicated to providing access to justice by arranging free Legal Aid and counseling for economically weaker sections helping them understand and safeguard their rights.

With deep respect for human values and cultural traditions, ABHINAV SAMAJ undertakes Antim Sanskar and Asthi Visarjan Sewa for unclaimed and destitute individuals ensuring that every person receives dignified last rites.

Through these efforts the mission of ABHINAV SAMAJ is to foster social harmony, promote compassion and contribute meaningfully to nation-building by transforming service into a way of life.

VISION

The vision of ABHINAV SAMAJ is to build a compassionate, inclusive and socially responsible society where every individual—especially the underprivileged elderly and marginalized—can live with dignity, security and hope. Guided by the timeless values of service (sewa), humanity and social justice ABHINAV SAMAJ envisions a society rooted in empathy and collective responsibility.

ABHINAV SAMAJ aspires to bridge social and economic inequalities by actively supporting those who are neglected or vulnerable, including destitute elderly persons, poor patients, children from slum areas and individuals without family or social support. The organization envisions ensuring access to basic necessities such as food, education, healthcare assistance, legal aid and dignified last rites for all regardless of caste, creed, religion or background.

A key element of ABHINAV SAMAJ's vision is to empower communities through education, awareness and capacity-building. By nurturing ethical values, civic responsibility and volunteerism—especially among youth and students—ABHINAV SAMAJ seeks to create socially conscious citizens committed to nation-building and humanitarian service.

ABHINAV SAMAJ also envisions preserving human dignity even after death by ensuring respectful last rites and religious rituals for unclaimed and destitute individuals, reaffirming the belief that every life has value.

AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS

PROGRAMS

ELDERLY CARE AND SUPPORT

Elderly Care and Support is one of the key areas of focus for ABHINAV SAMAJ. The organization recognizes the unique needs and challenges faced by the elderly population and is committed to providing them with the support and care they require.

The organization places significant emphasis on the care, respect, and well-being of senior citizens, especially those who are abandoned, destitute or without family support. Through its elderly-care initiatives and old age home services it provides a safe, dignified and nurturing environment for senior



citizens.

Facilities include shelter, nutritious meals, medical care, emotional support and recreational activities. Regular health check-ups, counseling sessions and assistance with daily activities ensure that the elderly live with dignity and security. The organization also fosters emotional bonding through community interaction, celebrations of festivals and volunteer engagement to reduce loneliness and social isolation among the elderly.

ABHINAV SAMAJ's initiatives related to elderly care and support include a range of programs aimed at improving the health, wellbeing and quality of life of senior citizens. These initiatives may include:

1. Membership:

JAI MAA DURGA OLD-AGE HOME

FREE FOOD DISTRIBUTION AT GOVERNMENT HOSPITALS IN DELHI/NCR

ABHINAV SAMAJ recognizes that access to nutritious food is a basic human right and is committed to addressing food insecurity at all government hospitals of Delhi and National Capital Region for the



attendants of poor patients taking treatment in those hospitals and their dependents. The



organization's food distribution initiatives aim to provide healthy and nutritious meals to individuals



and families staying at all government hospitals for taking care of their loved ones who are taking treatment in those hospitals. Since they have to live in many adverse situations at such places but ABHINAV SAMAJ feels that food is the most important factor for them since they have no money to purchase food outside such hospitals and any times have to live hungry.



Recognizing the hardships faced by attendants of poor patients in government hospitals, the organization regularly conducts free food distribution programs at major government hospitals. Many attendants come from economically weaker backgrounds and remain at hospitals for days without proper meals.



Under this initiative, freshly prepared and hygienic food is distributed free of cost to attendants, ensuring that hunger does not add to their suffering during critical times. This program provides immediate relief and reflects compassion toward families undergoing medical distress.

Under this program we have been distributing free food at all Government Hospitals in Delhi/NCR i.e. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital, Safdarjung Hospital, AIIMS, Hindu Rao Hospital, DDU Hospital etc. Healthy Food was supplied free of cost to needy people at these locations. Over 1 Million meals distributed by ABHINAV SAMAJ during this financial year.

IMPACT OF FREE FOOD DISTRIBUTION

Free food distribution at government hospitals has a significant humanitarian and social impact, particularly for attendants and families of economically weaker patients. Many caregivers travel from distant areas and spend days or even weeks at hospitals, often without access to affordable and nutritious meals. Providing free food ensures that they do not have to worry about hunger while caring for their loved ones.

This initiative helps reduce the financial burden on poor families who are already struggling with medical expenses. By meeting a basic need it allows attendants to focus on the patient's recovery rather than arranging food. Nutritious meals also help maintain their physical strength and emotional resilience during stressful times.

Moreover free food distribution promotes compassion, dignity and community support within the healthcare environment. It fosters a sense of solidarity and reassures families that they are not alone in difficult circumstances. Such efforts contribute to a more supportive hospital ecosystem and reflect a commitment to social responsibility and inclusive care.

Overall the program plays a vital role in alleviating hardship, supporting vulnerable communities and strengthening the spirit of service and humanity in society.

EDUCATION AND TRAINING

SUPPORTING UNDERPRIVILEGED CHILDREN

One of the core missions of ABHINAV SAMAJ is to empower underprivileged children by addressing their educational needs. Recognizing that education is the key to breaking the cycle of poverty, our organization has worked tirelessly to ensure that children living in slums and economically disadvantaged areas receive the support they need to stay in schools and succeed academically. Throughout the year we reached over 4,600 children across Delhi and NCR distributing essential stationery and book materials and providing educational support to those who need it most. Our initiatives aim not only to provide physical resources but also to create an environment where education is seen as a valuable and achievable goal for every child regardless of their socio economic background.

Education remains a cornerstone of the organization's mission. Through targeted education programs in slum areas the organization supports underprivileged children who lack access to basic educational resources.

The program includes distribution of books, notebooks, stationery, school bags and study material. In addition, the organization supports informal learning centers, remedial classes and motivational sessions to encourage school enrollment and reduce dropout rates. By addressing financial and material barriers, the initiative empowers children to pursue education and aspire for a better future.

Recognizing that access to materials alone is not enough, we also provide direct educational support to

children who need help with their studies. In collaboration with local schools and a dedicated team of volunteers ABHINAV SAMAJ offers after-school tutoring and mentorship programs. These programs focus on improving academic performance, helping children understand their schoolwork and boosting their confidence in subjects where they may be struggling. Our volunteers work closely with the children offering guidance and encouragement to help them stay on track with their education.

Our commitment to supporting underprivileged children has already borne fruit with many success



stories emerging from the communities we serve. Children who once struggled to stay in school are now excelling in their studies, thanks to the support they receive from ABHINAV SAMAJ. Parents too have become more invested in their children's education and we have seen a notable decrease in dropout rates in the areas where we work. The impact of our programs is far-reaching. By ensuring that children have access to education and the resources they need to succeed we are helping to build a brighter future not only for these children but for their families and communities as well.

As we continue our work, ABHINAV SAMAJ remains committed to expanding our reach and deepening our impact. We plan to extend our educational support to even more children across Delhi and NCR with a focus on integrating digital literacy into our programs to prepare students for the future. Our long-term vision is to create sustainable educational pathways for every child we serve, ensuring that they have the opportunity to rise above their circumstances and achieve their full potential.

Under this program total 500 School Bags were distributed to underprivileged students at JJ Colony Kali Basti Uttam Nagar N.Delhi, JJ Colony Kakrola N.Delhi, Kids Care Centre A-234 Bharat Vihar Kakrola, N.Delhi and Pathshala Classes B-73, Hastal Vihar, Uttam Nagar, N.Delhi.

Under this programme Free books and regular study material were distributed to underprivileged students JJ Colony Kali Basti Uttam Nagar N.Delhi, JJ Colony Kakrola N.Delhi, Kids Care Centre A-234 Bharat Vihar Kakrola, N.Delhi and Pathshala Classes B-73, Hastal Vihar, Uttam Nagar, N.Delhi.

TRAINING PROGRAM

The organization actively engages with youth and college students through structured training and awareness programs. These programs focus on social responsibility, leadership development, legal



awareness, community service and ethical values.

Students are trained through workshops, seminars, field exposure and volunteer activities helping them understand real-world social challenges. This initiative nurtures socially conscious citizens and encourages youth participation in nation-building and community welfare.

ABHINAV SAMAJ developed Curriculum jointly with Mahatma Gandhi College of Social Work and World Peace University for training to college students. ABHINAV SAMAJ implemented a structured 15-day Certificate Course on Elderly Care aimed at equipping college students with essential knowledge, practical skills and ethical sensitivity required to address the needs of an ageing population. The program responds to the growing demand for trained human resources in geriatric care by providing a comprehensive orientation to the physical, psychological and social aspects of ageing.

The course adopts an academic and experiential learning approach, combining classroom instruction with practical exposure to caregiving practices. Key areas of focus include personal care and hygiene, age-related health issues, effective communication with older adults, emotional support and the promotion of dignity and well-being among senior citizens. The program further emphasizes values of empathy, social responsibility, and community engagement.





The expected outcomes include enhanced student competence in basic elderly care practices, increased awareness of elder rights and social challenges associated with ageing and the development of positive attitudes towards community service and geriatric care professions. The program's impact is reflected in the number of students certified, increased participation in elderly welfare initiatives and strengthened community capacity to support senior citizens.

Through this initiative ABHINAV SAMAJ contributes to youth capacity building, social inclusion and the advancement of sustainable and compassionate approaches to elderly care.

The course emphasizes values of empathy, social responsibility and community engagement thereby fostering a cadre of informed and compassionate youth capable of contributing meaningfully to elder care services and social welfare initiatives. Through this academic-oriented training intervention, ABHINAV SAMAJ plays a significant role in capacity building, human resource development and the promotion of inclusive and sustainable approaches to elderly care within society.

Under this program, training was provided to more than 5000 students of various colleges in Distt. Bulandshahr (Uttar Pradesh) in the campus of DPBS College, Anupshahr (Uttar Pradesh). Obviously this training course improved the employment prospectus for children who trained by us.

IMPACT OF EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT AND TRAINING

Educational support for underprivileged children and training on elderly care for college students create a meaningful and long-lasting social impact by empowering both the younger and older generations. Providing books, study materials and academic assistance helps bridge the educational gap for children from disadvantaged backgrounds.

It improves their learning opportunities, boosts confidence, reduces dropout rates and encourages them to aspire for a brighter and more secure future.

The expected outcomes include enhanced student competence in basic elderly care practices, increased awareness of elder rights and social challenges associated with ageing, and the development of positive attitudes towards community service and geriatric care professions. The program's impact is reflected in the number of students certified, increased participation in elderly welfare initiatives and strengthened community capacity to support senior citizens.

At the same time training to college students on elderly care nurtures a sense of responsibility, empathy and respect for senior citizens. It equips young individuals with practical skills to understand the physical, emotional and psychological needs of the elderly, preparing them to contribute effectively to society. Such training also promotes volunteerism and inspires youth to participate in community service.

Together, these initiatives foster a culture of awareness, compassion and social inclusion. While educational support empowers children to break the cycle of poverty, elderly care training builds a generation that values dignity and care for older adults. The combined impact strengthens communities, encourages intergenerational support and contributes to building a more caring, educated and socially responsible society.

CONCLUSION

The educational support for underprivileged children and elderly care training for college students together represent a holistic approach to social development. By investing in education we empower children with the knowledge and confidence needed to shape a better future. Simultaneously, preparing young adults to care for the elderly fosters compassion, responsibility and a deeper understanding of societal needs.

In conclusion these initiatives not only uplift vulnerable sections of society but also cultivate a generation committed to service and humanity. Their combined impact promotes equality, strengthens community bonds and contributes to building a more inclusive, aware and supportive society for all.

BLANKET DISTRIBUTION

During extreme winter condition the organization conducts blanket distribution drives for homeless individuals, daily wage workers and people living in slums and on roads. Exposure to cold weather poses serious health risk particularly for the elderly and children.

By distributing blankets at night shelters, roadsides and slum clusters the organization helps protect vulnerable populations from harsh weather conditions. This initiative is carried out with dignity and compassion, often during late hours when the need is most acute.

ABHINAV SAMAJ organized a comprehensive blanket distribution program during the winter season with the aim of helping underprivileged and economically weaker sections of society cope with the severe cold. The initiative was undertaken as part of the organization's ongoing commitment to social service and community welfare. Volunteers of ABHINAV SAMAJ actively participated in identifying



needy individuals, including the homeless, daily wage workers, elderly people and poor families who are most affected during winter.

During the drive blankets were distributed with care and dignity ensuring that help reached those who needed it the most. The program not only provided physical warmth but also offered emotional support and a sense of belonging to the beneficiaries. Members of ABHINAV SAMAJ interacted with the recipients, spreading awareness about unity, compassion and the importance of helping one another in times of need.



This noble effort by ABHINAV SAMAJ highlighted the spirit of selfless service and social responsibility. The blanket distribution drive was widely appreciated by the local community and served as an inspiration for others to come forward and contribute to humanitarian causes, especially during challenging weather conditions.

LEGAL AID PROGRAM

To ensure access to justice for marginalized and vulnerable sections of society, the organization conducts free legal aid and legal awareness programs. These initiatives are especially beneficial for senior citizens, women, laborers and economically weaker individuals who cannot afford legal services.

Legal experts and volunteers provide guidance on issues related to pensions, property disputes, domestic violence, labor rights, documentation and government welfare schemes.

Awareness sessions educate beneficiaries about their legal rights and remedies, strengthening their ability to seek justice and protection under the law.



Although ABHINAV SAMAJ's programs span healthcare, shelter, food distribution, education and last-ritual support one notable initiative is its free legal aid program aimed specifically at senior citizens who lack access to affordable legal help.

Many elderly individuals — especially those abandoned, impoverished or cut off from family support — face legal issues like property disputes, denial of rightful pensions, neglect cases or family-law matters. Without financial means or legal knowledge they are often unable to seek justice or claim entitlements. ABHINAV SAMAJ's legal aid camps directly address this gap by offering:

- Free legal guidance and consultation
- Assistance in understanding senior citizens' rights
- Support in preparing and filing legal documentation
- Referral to pro-bono lawyers and advocates
- Help with legal issues arising from abandonment, exploitation, family disputes or pension/entitlement claims

ABHINAV SAMAJ organizes Legal Aid Camps periodically often in collaboration with legal professionals from M/s.Akash Rao & Jasmeen Kaur Associates a reputed law firm. Legal Aid Program for senior citizens periodically held at Exalt Tower near Uttam Nagar West Metro Station, New Delhi where elderly attendees are offered advice and information related to their rights and legal remedies.

These camps are typically open to all needy elderly beneficiaries without charge and focus on building legal awareness alongside direct counsel.

IMPACT ON THE NEEDY ELDERLY

The free legal aid camps organized by ABHINAV SAMAJ play a crucial role in:

- **Empowering elderly citizens with knowledge about their rights**
- **Reducing legal vulnerability in the absence of financial resources**
- **Encouraging access to justice for marginalized seniors**
- **Building confidence among elderly participants to take action on legal grievances**

These camps contribute to the larger mission of ensuring dignity, protection and legal equity for older adults who might otherwise remain unheard.

CONCLUSION

ABHINAV SAMAJ's initiative of regularly arranging free legal aid camps for needy elderly is an important extension of its social welfare mission. By bringing legal resources directly to the community — especially to seniors who lack the means to navigate complex legal systems — the organization helps safeguard their rights, resolve disputes and access justice with dignity and support.



ASTHIVISARJANSEWA

COMPASSIONATE SERVICE FOR THE FORGOTTEN

ABHINAV SAMAJ's one significant and deeply compassionate program is dedicated to the last rites of unclaimed bodies and the immersion of their ashes in the holy River Ganga at Sati Ghat, Haridwar.

As part of its humanitarian and spiritual service, the organization undertakes Asthi Visarjan Sewa for unclaimed, destitute and abandoned deceased individuals. The organization collects ashes from crematoriums and ensures that last rites are completed respectfully according to traditional rituals.

The ashes are immersed at holy places such as Haridwar ensuring spiritual dignity for those who had no family or support system. This service reflects the organization's deep commitment to human dignity even after death and upholds cultural and humanitarian values.



MISSION AND PURPOSE

In Indian spiritual and cultural beliefs, performing the proper funeral rites and "Asthi Visarjan" — the ritual of immersing ashes in a sacred river — is considered essential for the peaceful transition of the soul and its liberation (moksha). However many homeless, destitute or unclaimed individuals die without family leaving their bodies unattended in mortuaries or crematorium storage areas. ABHINAV SAMAJ's program aims to ensure that no human being's remains are left without dignity and ritual reverence.



COLLECTION AND RITUAL SERVICES

- ABHINAV SAMAJ conducts regular collection drives across all major crematoriums in Delhi.
- Members of the organization coordinate with Municipal Authorities and Police where necessary to retrieve ashes (asthi) of bodies that have been cremated but remain unclaimed or unattended.



- This work often involves logistical coordination — collecting urns or containers of ashes, documenting their retrieval and preparing for the next steps in the ritual process.
- After collection, the organization conducts the required rites in accordance with Hindu funeral traditions.
- These rituals include prayers, Vedic chants and ceremonial gestures that are believed to honor the departed soul's passage.

ASTHI VISARJAN AT HARIDWAR

- Once the ashes are collected and rites are completed locally ABHINAV SAMAJ arranges for immersion (visarjan) of the ashes in the holy Ganga at Haridwar specifically at Sati Ghat (a sacred site on the river) or other appropriate ghats.
- Haridwar is one of Hinduism's most holy cities for ash immersion rituals as the Ganga river is considered profoundly sacred and spiritually purifying.
- In Hindu dharma Asthi Visarjan in the Ganga is believed to help the soul achieve moksha (ultimate liberation) and mark the completion of its earthly journey with spiritual grace.
- By facilitating this rite for those who had no family or friends to do so, ABHINAV SAMAJ ensures that even the most vulnerable and forgotten individuals receive dignity in death.

BROADER SOCIAL AND SPIRITUAL IMPACT

This work not only addresses a humanitarian need but also speaks to the ethical and cultural value of dignity for every human life, irrespective of their socio-economic status.

- ABHINAV SAMAJ's efforts highlight how civil society organizations can step in to fill gaps left by public systems especially in matters that are deeply personal and spiritually significant.

CONCLUSION

The ashes collection and immersion program run by ABHINAV SAMAJ embodies a profound blend of social commitment, cultural respect and humanitarian service. By ensuring unclaimed bodies and their remains receive respectful rites and are immersed in the holy Ganga at Haridwar the organization restores dignity to lives that might otherwise be forgotten — offering them a final journey marked by care, compassion and spiritual observance.



- Volunteers and members of the organization act as symbolic family members standing in place of those who were absent in the deceased person's life.
- This initiative restores human dignity to individuals who were otherwise forgotten by society.
- It affirms the belief that every life has value regardless of economic status, identity or social position.

SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

ABHINAV SAMAJ fills a critical gap in the social welfare system by extending care beyond life and into death.

- The initiative promotes social awareness about compassion, responsibility and respect for the deceased.

CHALLENGES FACED

- Logistical challenges in coordinating with multiple crematoriums
- Transportation and administrative permissions
- Financial constraints related to travel, rituals and documentation
- Emotional and physical demands on volunteers

Despite these challenges ABHINAV SAMAJ continues this service with dedication and consistency.

FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

Financial Report of ABHINAV SAMAJ's financial analysis reveals the organization's fundraising activities, expenditure and its commitment to accountability and transparency.

In the Financial Year 2024-2025 ABHINAV SAMAJ received substantial contributions from donors, sponsors, and supporters. These resources were wisely allocated to enhance and maintain our diverse programs, aiding the most disadvantaged segments of society. Our financial report offers a comprehensive analysis of expenditures, guaranteeing transparency and accountability to all stakeholders.

EXPENDITURE BREAKDOWN

- Old Age Home: 10%
- Free Food Distribution: 60%
- Educational Support for Children: 5%
- Training to students: 10%
- Monthly Meetings and Support for Senior Citizens: 5%

Here is a breakdown of the key financial aspects:

SOURCE OF FUNDING

Domestic Contributions: ABHINAV SAMAJ successfully raised Rs. 28,77,234 from domestic sources. These funds likely came from individual donors, fundraising events and other local sources.

Foreign Contributions: The organization also received Rs. 4,96,16,387 as foreign contributions. These funds have come from international donors.

EXPENDITURE ALLOCATION

Program Expenses: ABHINAV SAMAJ allocated Rs. 4,31,28,200 directly to various programs aimed at benefiting the community. This allocation demonstrates the organization's focus on addressing important social issues such as Old Age Home support, Food Distribution, Education etc. Such programs directly contribute to the organization's mission and have a positive impact on the target beneficiaries.

Administrative & Management Expenses: A portion of the funds raised was allocated towards Administrative & Management expenses. An Amount of Rs.68,44,151 was spend on Administrative, and Misc. expenses. It was essential for the smooth functioning of the organization. Administrative expenses typically include staff salaries, office rent, utilities, legal fees and other operational costs. Our Administrative expenses came to 14 % only of the entire funds raised and are according to the parameters fixed maximum expenses by government.

INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL AUDIT

ABHINAV SAMAJ maintains an internal and external audit system. This indicates a commitment to financial accountability and the implementation of checks and balances. Internal audits help ensure compliance with financial policies and procedures while external audits provide an independent assessment of the organization's financial statements.

BENEFICIARIES

Out of ABHINAV SAMAJ's social initiatives 1418 under privilege children were benefitted with school books and study materials, 529 college students were benefitted by training on elderly-care, hospice and geriatric care (Certificates were provided to them for their future support), 58 senior citizens were benefitted in our old age home under elderly care program, 926376 meals were distributed at different government hospitals and 626 blankets were distributed to roadside persons during winter.

COMPLETE ACCOUNTABILITY AND TRANSPARENCY

By emphasizing complete accountability and transparency, ABHINAV SAMAJ demonstrates its commitment to responsible financial management. This commitment is crucial in maintaining the trust of donors, stakeholders and the community at large. To perform a comprehensive financial analysis it is essential to review the organization's Audited financial statements including the Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure statement and cash flow statements. 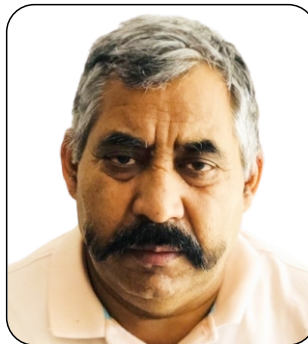
